

GDF SUEZ receives the Diversity Label

Following an audit by Association Francaise de Normalisation (AFNOR, the French standards authority) GDF SUEZ has received the Diversity Label, which recognizes and rewards the actions undertaken by GDF Suez in the prevention of discrimination, equality of opportunity and the promotion of diversity. This label covers 42,000 employees at GDF SUEZ.

The process which is now being extended to all 108 000 Group employees in France will be re-audited by AFNOR by 18 months. The new audit will scrutinize the sustainability of the measures taken and assess the new measures introduced since the award of the Label.

Gérard Mestrallet, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of GDF SUEZ commented: "Receiving this label is the fruit of continuous commitment from many people within the Group to recognize and promote diversity."
