## Responsible Business in Poland 2012 report published

The Responsible Business Forum - the biggest CSR network in Poland - has recently released the "Responsible business in Poland 2012. Good practices". The publication is the 11th edition of the good practice toolkit.

The report is a summary of the activities undertaken by companies in the domain of corporate social responsibility and sustainable development. It also provides an abstract of all the relevant CSR events that took place last year in Poland. A core element of the publication is the list of corporate good practices - with a total of 262 practices submitted by 106 companies over the year 2012.

The best CSR practices presented in the report, which include tested activities, programmes or projects undertaken by companies, were broken down into seven areas that are the core subjects of ISO 26000 (the international standard on socially responsible behaviour), such as Organisational Governance, Human Rights, Labour Practices, The Environment, Fair Operating Practices, Consumer Issues, and Local Community Involvement and Development.
