

ORSE and ILO release study on social security and CSR

The French CSR organisation, Observatoire de la Responsabilité Sociétale des Entreprises (ORSE), and the International Labor Organisation (ILO) have published a study entitled "The extension of social security and the social responsibility of multinational enterprises: An exploratory study".

The study includes interviews conducted with eight enterprises – Agence Française du Développement, Danone, Lafarge, Orange, Sanofi, Total, Véolia Environnement, Vallourec – as well as the synthesis of the social protection guarantees voluntarily implemented by those multinational companies.
