



## Michel Doucin

*H.E. Michel Doucin is the French ambassador for bioethics and corporate social responsibility since 2008. Over the years, he has taken on a large number of functions dealing with cultural diplomacy, development policy, economy and relations with civil society. In parallel, he has been a university professor in famous places like Sciences Po Paris, Ecole Nationale d'Administration and Université Paris-Sud-Jean Monnet. He left the Ministry of Foreign Affairs several times to take on positions in the Ministry of Culture, the Ministry of Regional Development and Prime Minister Office. For instance, he was asked in 1999 by the Prime Minister to set up an advisory body designed to channel the desiderata and criticisms of civil society regarding French International Cooperation : the High Council for International Cooperation. As a diplomat, he was successively General Consul and Director of the French Cultural Institute in Naples (Italy) and General Consul in Mainz (Germany) in the 90ies. He was appointed as Ambassador at large for Human Rights between 2005 and 2008.*
