The Libra Group**

George Logothetis, age 38, is Chairman and CEO of the Libra Group, an international business group with 30 operating subsidiaries spanning 25 locations across four continents. The group is predominantly focused on shipping, aviation, real estate, hospitality and renewable energy.

George joined his family's shipping company in 1993, becoming CEO in 1994 at the age of 19. In the ensuing years he presided over the company's transformation from three vessels into a fleet of 55 before creating the Libra Group in 2003.

The group undertakes numerous educational and philanthropic initiatives globally. These include support for MBA students at Athens University of Business and Economics, and the Hellenic Entrepreneurship Award, created by Libra with a €5 million commitment to provide funding and mentoring for start-up businesses in Greece. The company also supports 35 students per annum from Greece and the Greek diaspora with internships at the Libra Group and its subsidiaries across the world.

George and his wife, Nitzia, also founded the Seleni Institute, a New York-based non-profit organisation that addresses women's reproductive and maternal mental health.
