Ms Dziurman started working in Greece in 1979 in the tourism sector and changed career following an MBA. Her first contract with the EBRD was in 1991, setting up a training course for privatisation officials in St Petersburg, before becoming an expert for the development of viable commercial banking sectors in former USSR countries. She spent 12 years as a freelance consultant focussing on banking and SME credit lines for the EBRD, but also for DFID and World Bank. Sabina became a staff member of EBRD in 2004; she initially joined the Group for Small Business and later the Financial Institutions Group. She successfully led landmark transactions such as the rescue of Latvia's Parex Bank and the EBRD's first investment in Cyprus in the Bank of Cyprus. Ms. Dziurman was appointed Director for Greece and Cyprus in July 2015 and is based in Athens. A British citizen, she was educated at London University and London Business School.
