



Georgios Kaminis
Mayor of Athens, Greece

Mr. Kaminis was first elected Mayor of Athens on November 2010. He was re-elected mayor for a second term in May 2014. Prior to his election as a Mayor of Athens, Mr. Kaminis served as Greek Ombudsman. From 1998 to May 2003, he was Deputy Ombudsman for Human Rights at the Greek Ombudsman. In 2003, he was elected Greek Ombudsman by the Greek Parliament, and he was re-elected for a second term in 2007. In August 2010, Mr. Kaminis resigned from the post of the Greek Ombudsman in order to stand as an independent mayoral candidate for the City of Athens. Mr. Kaminis is assistant professor of constitutional law in the Faculty of Law at the University of Athens and member of the scientific staff in the Department of Parliamentary Studies and Research, Directorate of Studies, in the Greek Parliament. Mr. Kaminis studied law at the University of Athens, and holds a doctoral degree (Doctorat d'Etat) from the University of Paris 1. He was born in New York City and in addition to his native Greek language, he speaks fluently English, French and Spanish. Mr. Kaminis is married and has two children.
